

STORY OF CROYDON

You will need:

- ✓ **Croydon Newspaper front page**
- ✓ **Pens**
- ✓ **Video camera or sound recorder** (optional)

It's 2020. All the changes you wanted to see after the Commission has finished its work have happened. Tell the story of what it's like, how it happened, and who made it happen in *Story of Croydon*.

What big difference will we see in five years' time? And how did it happen? This is your chance to show us the differences you want to see and how much better things will be if they become a reality.

You can do this individually or in small groups.

Each person or small group needs a copy of the Croydon Newspaper front page. Here you can write the Story of Croydon you want to see in five years. Your front page has three parts:

- **Main story:** what's the biggest outcome you want to see from our work? Write a catchy headline and a column on what has changed or what has happened.
- **The people who made it happen:** who made this story happen? Write a paragraph on the people or organisations who you hope will have made your story possible.
- **More inside:** this is a space for you to list a few other stories you'd love to see in five years' time.

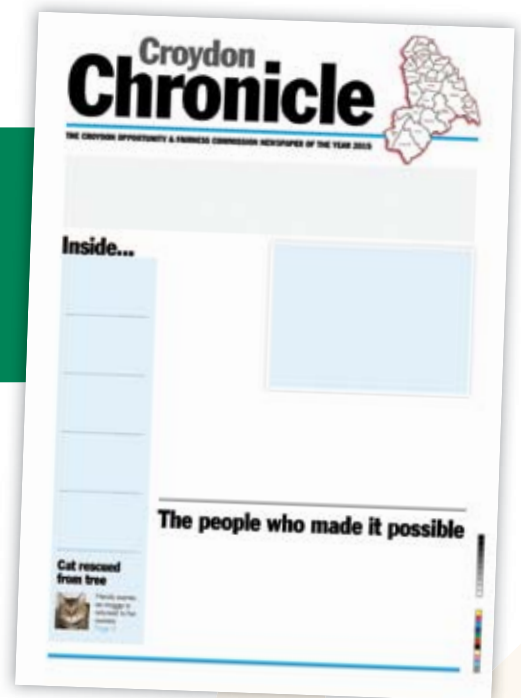
Write your headline at the top of the page - try to keep it short and catchy.

Add a photo or draw a picture that sums up your story.

Now, as a group, put your stories together and tell each other your front page stories.
